- Each entry costs €45.00 per product entered. Return your entry on the attached form by post or fax. ENTRY IS CONFIRMED ONLY WHEN FEE HAS BEEN PAID TO ACBI.
- Best hygiene practise is required at all stages of the competition.
- All meats to be used in the competition must be Irish and should be prepared or processed on the premises of the participant.
- Please describe your entry on the form, e.g. Texas Ribs, Spicy Kebab, BBQ Chicken, (but not in such a way as to identify the entrant e.g. Murphy's Best Burger).
- Entries should have recognisable barbeque characteristics which distinguish them from products intended for other uses (this requirement is interpreted flexibly).
- You may enter a total of six products, but no more than three in any one category.
- Entries will only be accepted from an affiliated shop or member in the competition.
- You must bring one cooked and one uncooked sample per entry.
- The cooked sample should ideally be barbecued.
- The organisers accept no responsibility for any damage or loss to entries.
- Entry forms with fees should be with ACBI no later than Friday 12th of JUNE.
- ENTRY WILL BE REFUSED IF PAYMENT IS NOT MADE IN ADVANCE.
- Only paid up members of ACBI are eligible to enter.
- All entries must be brought on a disposable plate or platter ready for display no later than **3 pm**.
- The judges' decision will be final.
- Please note that sausages have been removed from the BBQ Competition and can be entered in the National Sausage and Pudding Competition.
